

## Schooling Hours for the Arabians in Motion Back-to-Basics Dressage Show

- We have not rented any of the outdoor arenas; please do not use them!
- Paddocks, round pens and the hot walker are for the use of DevonWood boarders only.

### Lungeing

- Lungeing is permitted only in the lungeing arena at the south end of the lower stables, and only during daylight hours.
- For safety's sake, only two horses may be lunged at once.
- Do not turn your horse loose in the lungeing arena.
- See USEF rule book, DR 121 for legal equipment.  
(No draw reins, no longlining or ground driving, no Western saddles, etc.)

### Schooling in the Competition Arena

- The competition arena will be open for schooling on Friday afternoon until approximately 7PM, when it will be closed for grooming.
- It will be open again on Saturday evening after the last ride until approximately 7PM, when it will be closed for grooming.
- The competition arena will remain closed until 1 hour before the first ride of the morning. At that time, you may hand-walk your horse around the *outside* of the competition arena.
- For safety, no one is allowed on foot in the competition arena.
- Again, lungeing is allowed only in the lunging arena at the south end of the lower stables.

### Schooling in the Warm-Up Arena

- The warm-up arena is open for schooling under saddle until the facility closes for the night (between 8:30 and 9 PM).
- For safety, no one is allowed on foot in the warm-up arena.
- Again, lungeing is allowed only in the lunging arena at the south end of the lower stables.
